#### Agreement to be read prior to completing application.

- The applicant must be a current financial member of SAWMA and must remain a financial member for the duration of their research.
- SAWMA research grants are issued at the discretion of the SAWMA Committee by a majority agreement.
- The research grant is generally to a maximum of \$5000.
- A detailed record of monies spent must be kept and provided to the SAWMA Committee. Any unused monies remaining at the completion of the project are to be returned to SAWMA.
- The outcomes from the research are to be presented by a person involved in the project at a SAWMA Education Night Meeting.
- A synopsis of the research (not more than 500 words) is to be provided by a person involved in the project for publication in the SAWMA newsletter 'Wound Wisdom'.
- Regular reports (at least six monthly) on research progress will be requested for projects that extend beyond twelve months.
- The research must support or advance wound management practice within South Australia.
